13. DUTIES OF THE TREASURERS

The Treasurer shall deposit the amount in the Bank or in the Post Office approved by the Executive Committee. He/She shall however keep such portion of the cash money with him/her as may from time to time be fixed by the Executive Committee.

14. FINANCIAL YEAR OF THE SOCIETY

15. AMENDMENT OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Rules and Regulation of the society shall not be amended except at a special General Meeting of the society and by a majority or three/four of the members of the society and provided that notice shall be sent in writing to all the members at least 15 (fifteen) days before the date of meeting.
